### Child & Adolescent Oral Health Service - June 2013

Welcome to Child and Adolescent Oral Health Service's update for June.

We are pleased to advise that the reconfiguration of the service delivery model for the Child and Adolescent Oral Health Service is in its final stage. All nine mobile dental clinics are operational and the majority of school-based clinics decanted except for the Feilding and Tararua areas where school-based clinics will continue to be used until the planned dental facility within the Integrated Family Health Centre facilities are developed.
