Yesterday Nick announced his resignation as principal of Kumeroa-Hopelands School. We congratulate Nick on his appointment as the new principal of Oroua Downs School. Nick’s last day with us will be the 26th of July.

While we are sad to see him go, we understand his desire to progress his career into the management of larger schools and know he will go on to do great things. We have really enjoyed having Nick lead our team, recreate our school and set us a strong foundation for the future. We wish him well and feel proud that we have been part of his progression.

The Board will shortly advertise for applicants for the Principal’s position.

This year’s lower school roll, and similar projections for next year impact significantly on the principal’s position, and this has contributed to Nick’s decision to progress his career earlier than we may have expected.
